Literacy Center

Our winter after-school session begins this month and runs through February, and our fall ABC Program will be ending December 10 and 11. Winter Parking Code Update

Lehi City has updated its winter parking regulations to improve snow removal and safety on city streets.

No on-street parking is allowed during snow storms and for 48 hours after a storm ends or when snow or ice accumulation reaches 1 inch or more on the traveled roadway.

Overnight parking is now allowed during the winter months outside of these conditions.

Lehi Police will provide additional enforcement of this new code. Thank you for helping keep our roads safe and clear this winter!
